**Subject: Declaration of Final Result of Junior Hindi Translator, Junior Translator and Senior Hindi Translator Examination, 2023 - regarding.**

Result of Paper-I of Junior Hindi Translator, Junior Translator and Senior Hindi Translator Examination, 2023 was declared on 23.11.2023. Thereafter, Paper-II of the Examination was conducted on 31.12.2023.

2. As per relevant provisions of the Notice of the said Examination, Document Verification (DV) would be done by the Indenting/ User Departments. Further, as per Para 15 of the Notice of said Examination Option-cum-preference would be taken online from the candidates before declaration of the final result.

3. Accordingly, as per Important Notice dated 22.02.2024 of the said Examination, Option-cum-preference has been taken online from the candidates from 22.02.2024 to 26.02.2024, who had appeared in Paper-II of the said Examination. A total of 1985 candidates, who had submitted their Option-cum-Preference online, have been considered for further selection process.

4. Allocation of Posts and Departments to the provisionally shortlisted candidates has been made on the basis of the performance of candidates in Paper-I & Paper-II and the preference of Posts/ Departments submitted by them online.

5. Keeping in view the vacancy position, category-wise details of 296 candidates provisionally shortlisted for appointment to various posts in different Ministry/ Departments/ Offices are as given below:

8. Resolution of Tie cases: As per provisions in Para 17 of Notice of the said Examination, in cases where more than one candidate has secured the equal aggregate marks in Paper-I + Paper-II, tie has been resolved by applying the following methods one after another in the given order till the tie is resolved:

- i) Total marks in Paper-II.
- ii) Marks in Part (i) of Paper-I (i.e. General Hindi).
- iii) Date of birth, with older candidates placed higher.
- iv) Alphabetical order of the names of the candidates.

9. Any discrepancy with respect to the selection/ non-selection/ allocation of post/ User Department, etc may be brought to the notice of the Commission within a period of one month. Any such representation received after one month will not be entertained by the Commission

10. Post declaration of the final result of the Examination, further process of Document Verification and Appointment formalities will be undertaken by the Allocated Department to the shortlisted candidates. If a candidate does not receive any correspondence from the concerned allocated User Department within a period of six months from the declaration of final result, he/she must communicate immediately thereafter with the concerned User Department. Further, the Commission will not, in any circumstances, entertain any correspondences regarding Document Verification/appointment formalities from the shortlisted candidates.

11. No Reserve List/ Waiting List is prepared by the Commission. Unfilled vacancies in the final result and vacancies arising out of non-joining of shortlisted candidates will be carried forward to the subsequent year(s) by the concerned Departments/Organisations.

12. Marks of the shortlisted / not-shortlisted candidates will be uploaded on the website of the Commission shortly.
